

# Suffolk Festival Championship & Awards

For non-Dance disciplines competitors must achieve "Distinction" or above in one of the qualifying classes and "Commended" in the others for each championship.

Senior Dance competitors must achieve an 86 or above in one of the qualifying classes and "Commended" in the others. Junior Dance competitors must achieve "Commended" or above in all qualifying classes. These align with the qualifying marks for All England Dance.

For other awards and trophies a "Commended" or above must be achieved in each qualifying class.
